

# 2 SCHOOLS? 1 FAFSA!

## WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW

**Are you taking classes at a school other than WSU?**

**Are you using FAFSA funding to pay for those classes?**

**If you answered yes, then you will need to complete a WSU financial aid consortium agreement after you register each semester.**

### MINNESOTA STATE SCHOOLS

Complete the online consortium agreement for each semester after you register at another Minnesota State school.  
([winona.edu/financial-aid/consortium-agreement.asp](http://winona.edu/financial-aid/consortium-agreement.asp))

If you change the course, section, or school after you submit the consortium agreement, please complete another agreement with updated information. Any change in enrollment can impact financial aid disbursement.

If you are registering for summer session courses, you must also complete a summer financial aid application.

### NON-MINNESOTA STATE SCHOOLS

Complete the student section of the Non-Minnesota State Consortium Agreement form (PDF) after you register for each semester at a school outside of the Minnesota State system (a.k.a. visiting school).

Then, mail or fax the consortium agreement to the Financial Aid Office of the visiting school.

- You may only have ONE school manage your FAFSA. This is known as your HOMESCHOOL.
- Two-year community colleges cannot fund upper division courses (300-400) from WSU. (Exception: SOCW340&350 because they are Program Admission pre-requisites)
- Ask questions! A college education is an investment in your future. Like any other investment, it's important to understand the financial aid process so you can make the best choice for your needs.
